MATH

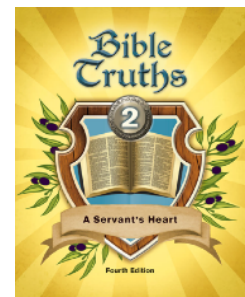
Math Club - Students will have fun working on various math projects, playing games, and strengthening their math skills. (This class is designed to supplement what you are learning at home.)

BIBLE

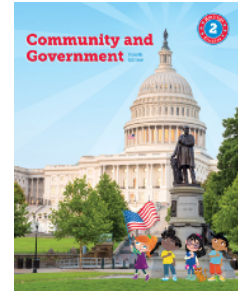

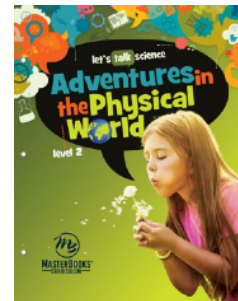
SOCIAL STUDIES
